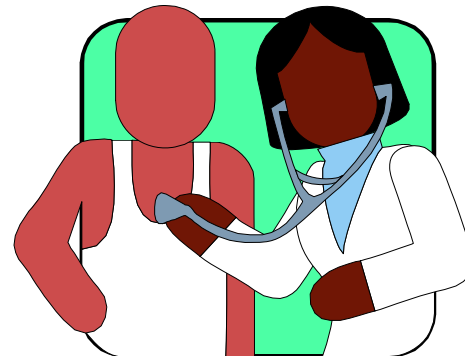

Brain Quadrants

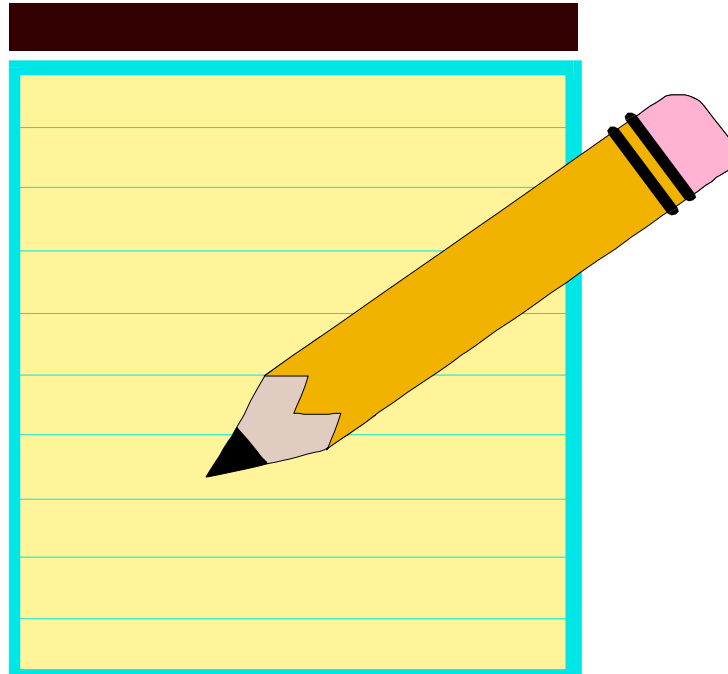




Total Population

- 5% - 1 quadrant dominant
- 58% - 2 quadrant dominant
- 34% - 3 quadrant dominant
- 3% function in all 4 quadrants equally

Enhance Retention

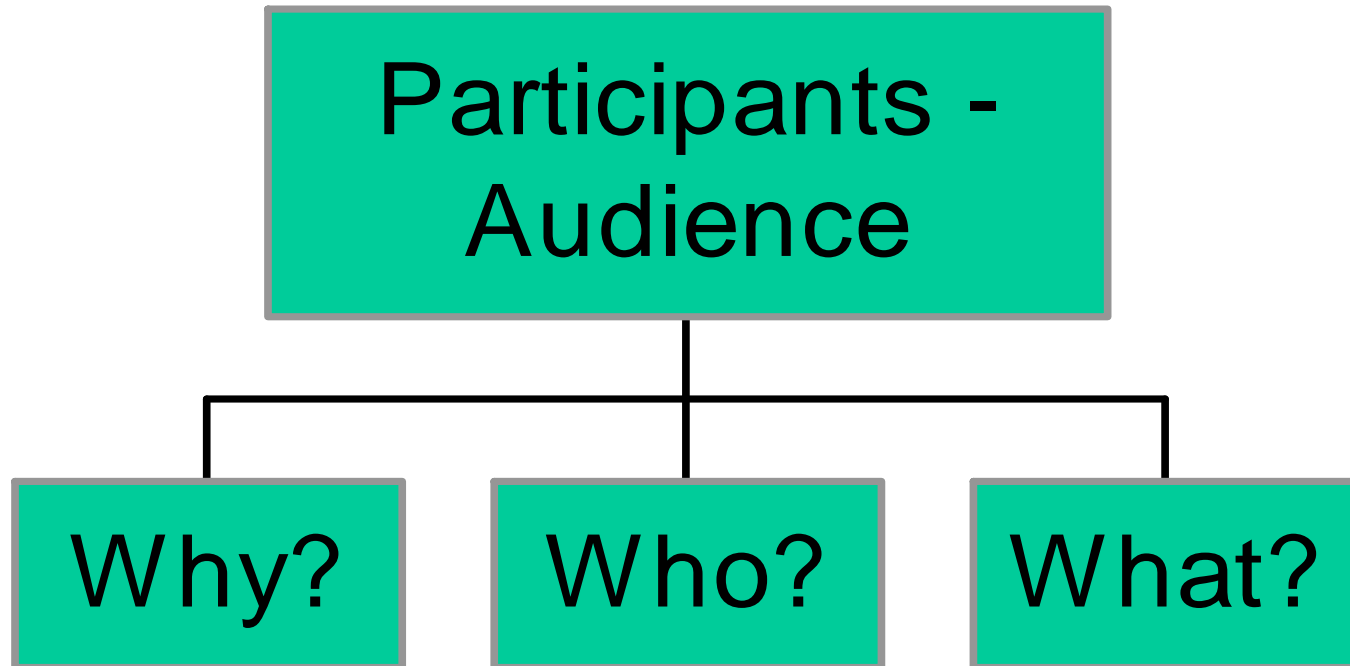
- Active involvement of mind
