* The Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (Byrne JAG) penalty is estimated at 2 percent of state's total award. Because the penalty applies to correctional facilities under a state or territory's operational control, the penalty is expected to apply to the state/territory portion of the Byrne JAG award, after calculation of the Variable Pass Through (VPT), which is the portion of the state formula grant required to be passed through to units of local government. This percentage varies by state; therefore, the penalty will also vary by state. Most states are required to pass through between 50-60 percent of their total award. This 2 percent will remain a rough estimate, however, until the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS) calculates the annual grant award and VPT amounts for FY14.
