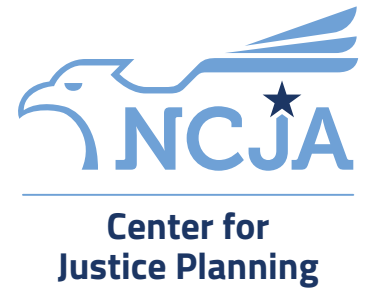


Byrne JAG & Byrne SCIP Support for State Administering Agencies

With support from the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), [NCJA's Center for Justice Planning \(NCJP\)](#) provides training and technical assistance (TTA) to state administering agencies (SAAs) managing the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (Byrne JAG) program and the Byrne State Crisis Intervention Program (Byrne SCIP). The NCJP also provides TTA to local Criminal Justice Planning Boards (CJPBs) and Criminal Justice Coordinating Councils (CJCCs). The NCJP's TTA program provides a wide variety of resources and guidance to help SAAs ensure Byrne JAG and Byrne SCIP funding is administered effectively, from planning to reporting outcomes.

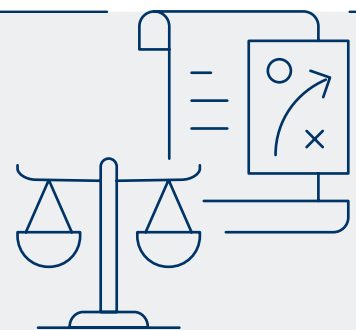

Strategic Planning & Stakeholder Engagement

- Creation and analysis of stakeholder needs assessment surveys
- Facilitation of focus groups to identify state priorities
- Supporting states in their processes for identifying priorities for funding
- Review of state and CJCC strategic plans, upon request, to identify areas for improvement
- Facilitation of public safety planning board meetings, including presentations and structured planning/brainstorming sessions with state leadership and/or SAA staff
- Assistance in engaging specific types of stakeholders such as rural or community-based partners
- Process improvement and engagement support for CJCCs and public safety planning boards
